

Impact of 2013/14 PE Funding

Item	Impact
NQT support	We have had two NQT teachers supported throughout the year. They are much more confident in delivering PE
Whole school training in Gymnastics	Staff are feeling much more confident in delivering Gymnastics and the children are developing quality skills in gymnastics.
Young Leaders programme	Our Year six children are providing young leaders in the playground during lunch for the rest of the school.
To apply for awards	We have received the Kite Mark (Sainsbury award) and the Quality Mark with the Gold standard (YST)
Gifted & Talented	We have completed an identification workshop and from this developed a Talented List. This list of children participated in a Talented programme that ran for 6 weeks. Some children chose to participate in further programmes offered by the partnership. This will continue each year.
Inter Competitions	We have ran 3 inter competitions (The 3 days were Cross country, Bike event and Athletics) as well as a sports day.
Competitions	We were able to increase our competitions ensuring that each year group were able to be a part of a competition which broadened the sporting opportunities.
Introduced new sport -Lacrosse	We were able to purchase equipment and train our PE teacher to teach the skills. This improved participation in sport throughout KS2.
Sports Partnership	This has allowed us to participate in competitions which help to drive the competitive spirit and inspire children to develop their skills.
Equipment and staff	This has help to pay for specialised coaches to develop quality skills and provide equipment for our new sport (Lacrosse).
