Literacy

We will be learning to write diary entries and newspaper reports. We will incorporate all the features for each text type with added focus on; the past tense, adjectives, conjunctions and feelings in our writing.

We will be continuing to learn how to join our handwriting and improve the presentation of our work.

We will be continuing with spelling and grammar work to help us develop our command of the English language spoken and written.

Ways to help at home

-Practising phonics sounds, tricky words and spellings.

- Listen to your child read daily and ask them questions about the text.

Big maths

We will be looking at:

<u>Counting:</u> continuing – 3 digit multiples of a 100, partitioning 2 digit numbers, understanding numbers to 20, counting in 2s

Learn its: 8+3=11, 9+3=12

<u>It's nothing new:</u> double 2d multiples of 10, know half of 30, 50, 70, 90, fact families

<u>Calculations:</u> add 10 to 2d tens and any 2d number; take 10 from multiple of 10 and a 2d number; take multiple of 10 from multiple of 10,write and solve repeated addition, grouping objects.
