## Adaptations to St. Helen's Behaviour Policy during the phased return (June 2020) during the COVID 19 Pandemic

This should be read alongside our Current Behaviour Policy (October 2018)

## INTRODUCTION

From June 1<sup>st</sup>, pupils in Years R, 1 and 6 have been invited to return to school alongside children of Critical Workers (some of whom have been attending school during the lockdown period).

All these pupils have been allocated to a bubble of no more than 15 pupils - this is in line with government guidance in order to prevent the spread of infection.

Bubbles will stay as separate units all day and this is to prevent the risk of any cross infection.

Below are our new school rules for the pupils – they will need to be adapted and explained in an age appropriate manner:

## NEW SCHOOL RULES FOR WHEN WE COME BACK TO SCHOOL IN JUNE

- I will show respect to everyone in my bubble including the 2 adults.
- I understand it might be more difficult for some people to return to school than others and I will be as kind and helpful as possible.
- At the beginning of the day It is very important that I arrive at school at the special time for my bubble and come into school the way I have been asked - this is to try and keep us all safe and well.
- When an adult collects me from school or I leave school on my own (year 6 – as agreed with parents), I know that it is important that I leave the school grounds quickly and do not stay to have a chat with my friends.
- My bubble family have an indoor and an outdoor area these are the only areas that I can go to unless told otherwise by an adult. We will have our playtimes and lunchtimes in either our indoor or outdoor area altogether as a bubble family.
- When an adult tells me that it's time for handwashing, it is important that I wash my hands properly with soap and water or

hand sanitiser and for the right amount of time – remember to sing happy birthday in your head twice!

- When I sneeze, it is important to use a tissue and then put it in the bin with the lid and then wash my hands. Remember: Catch it, Bin it, Kill it.
- If I need to cough, I will remember to cough into my elbow.
- At all times I will try not to touch my mouth, nose or eyes with my hands.
- If I don't feel well, I must tell an adult straight away.
- The only things that I will bring from home are my water bottle and my lunchbox if having a home packed lunch.
- I must not use anyone else's equipment and especially not their water bottle.
- I need to tell an adult when I need to use the toilet it is very important to keep our toilets clean.
- I will try to give everyone their own personal space.
- If I behave inappropriately and others feel unsafe and upset, I will be removed from my bubble and will have to spend the rest of the day with Mrs Curtis, Mrs Faulkner or Mrs Mouchel.

EVERYONE WITHIN OUR BUBBLE MUST BE ABLE TO FEEL SAFE AND HAPPY.
