




St Helen's Mission Statement

Nurture Group Principles.


The staff in the Nurture room and all school staff are fully committed to the Nurture Group Principles.


- **Children's learning is understood developmentally.**

Children are not withdrawn from the curriculum but it is modified to enable them to engage in it at their appropriate developmental level.

- **It is understood that all behaviour is communication.**

Children learn to develop appropriate behaviour and responses and self esteem. There is a strong emphasis on the development of learning behaviours and opportunities for intensive practice of them.







- The classroom offers a safe base
Children in the Nurture Group learn to feel emotionally safe and secure at school.

- Nurture is important for the development of self-esteem
Self esteem and self confidence is fostered in a therapeutic environment.

- Language is a vital means of communication

Children will remain members of their school classes and will develop the confidence to manage changes from one situation to another.







This is our home area
